ClubGRANTS is one of Australia's largest grant programs, providing more than \$100 million in cash each year by registered Clubs to a variety of worthy causes across NSW.

Charities, sporting organisations and not-for-profit community groups are among tens-of-thousands of worthy causes funded through the program each year.

In 2024, St. George Masonic Club proudly contributed \$34,000 in cash grants through Category 1 and Category 2 funding to an array of local organisations who in turn execute programs within the community.

The Vet connect project increases connections with family, friends, local communities, and volunteering. The project includes services for local veterans including social peer meet ups, weekend activities for spouses & families tied with regular club engagement activities.	\$7,500.00

The school encourages students to utilise the offering because for some students it is the only meal of the day due to the current financial pressures on families. It is also a friendly space for all students & teachers to stop by and enjoy the meals and smoothies on offer.
